1-2-1, 1-2-2 and Small Workshop Additional Information

What You Need To Bring

- Suitable clothing & sturdy footwear (including wet weather gear)
- Camera
- Lenses
 - Ideally a UWA, standard and telephoto zoom.
- Tripod (I can loan you one if you don't have one)
- Camera filters
- Snacks, meals or drinks

What Is Included

- Photography tuition
 - (half day is 4-5 hours, full day is 8-9 hours)
- Short e-mail feedback on 4-5 of your favourite photos from the day
- A retweet/share of my favourite photo of yours from the workshop via my social media

What Is Not Included

- Transport to agreed meeting location
- Transport between locations during workshop
- Any meals such as breakfast, lunch or dinner
- Insurance for you or your equipment
- Accommodation

Covid-19 Alterations

- Hand sanitising gel will be available.
- Please bring a mask to enable visiting museums or indoor attractions for photography tuition, especially while in London.
- The loan of photography equipment of mine is temporarily suspended (bar pre cleaned tripod).
- Car transfer using my vehicle between locations is temporarily suspended so you will need to use your vehicle or I base any 1-2-1/workshop in one location or ones that can be walked to and from.

Terms & Conditions

1. Workshops are subject to a 25% non refundable deposit on booking, which is only refundable if I was to cancel the workshop.
2. The balance of payment is to be made 7 days before the workshop begins.
3. If you are unable to attend the workshop due to your circumstances then there is no refund. I advise you take out insurance to cover this unlikely eventuality.
4. If, for any reason, a workshop needs to be cancelled by myself then I will give you a full refund for the cost of the workshop. Please note this would not cover any costs spent on transport to/from the workshop or any accommodation you may have booked.
5. Outdoor landscape photography workshops are susceptible to weather and as such there is no promise that conditions shown in photos used to advertised said workshops will lead you to be able to shoot in similar circumstances. If a workshop needs to be delayed or rearranged due to incredibly bad weather then your booking cost will be fully transferred to the new date. Please note, as in item 4 of the T&Cs, there will be no refund of your travel costs or accommodation in such circumstances.

6. If I am unable to attend the workshop due to personal illness then a full refund will be given, but not including any of your costs such as transport or accommodation costs.
7. As an attendee of the workshop, it is your responsibility to insure your equipment for theft, loss or damage, yourself through personal accident insurance and travel insurance. My liability is covered under my public liability insurance (PLI), of which a copy of the certificate is available on request.
8. While you are undertaking my workshops, your safety is my top priority. You must, at all times, take instructions from myself that are given with your best interests at heart. This includes, but not limited too, your proximity to cliff tops, river edges, seawater etc. Any injuries or death as a result of ignoring these instructions are not the fault of myself.
9. If a workshop needs to be cancelled or delayed due to Covid-19 local or national lockdowns, then a full refund will be given including the non-refundable deposit. However, I believe it is in the best interests of both of us for the workshop to be rearranged in either date or location. This may involve the workshop running on the same date but at a different location (if the original one is subject to a local lockdown) if this means both of us can attend from areas not in local lockdown.
